

# Editorial



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
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

With participation from ministers, industry leaders, manufacturers and technical experts, the conclave showcased Bihar's rapid progress in renewable energy, grid modernization, smart metering and large-scale investments, and highlighted the state's readiness for new opportunities.
- Adding to the quarter's achievements, both SBPDCL and NBPDC earned national recognition at the India Energy Summit and ICC Innovation with Impact Awards 2025, winning top ranks in technology adoption, innovation and operational performance. These honours reflect the dedication of the workforce and the strategic reforms that have positioned Bihar's DISCOMS among the most progressive in the country.
- This edition also celebrates cultural expression through Independence day, Hindi Diwas, Diwali and other celebration and heartfelt poetry contributed by employees, capturing pride, identity and the shared spirit that defines the Urja Parivar.

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## From Access to Assurance : Bihar's Journey Towards Universal Energy Security

### Bihar's Power Sector - A Journey of Transformation and Collective Resolve

Over the past two decades, Bihar's power sector has undergone a transformation unmatched by most Indian states. What was once a system marked by scarcity, unreliable supply and public dissatisfaction has evolved into one defined by stability, financial discipline and consumer-first governance. In 2005, even urban Bihar struggled with just five to six hours of supply, while large parts of rural regions remained in darkness. Today, the state delivers 23–24 hours of reliable power across both urban and rural areas—reshaping daily life, productivity and public confidence.

This progress is reflected in the numbers. Peak demand has risen from 700 MW in 2005 to over 8,752 MW in 2025; electrified villages expanded from 14,020 to more than 39,000; and AT&C losses fell from nearly 60% to 15.5%, even surpassing the national average.

Yet Bihar's true achievement lies in the participation of its people. Consumers adopted smart meters, shifted to prepaid and digital payments, attended panchayat-level camps, engaged transparently with grievance systems and built trust in DISCOM processes. Their behaviour change strengthened financial stability and enabled the government to reinvest in subsidies, networks and consumer-centric reforms.

It is this shared foundation of governance and public cooperation that made possible one of the most far-reaching welfare decisions in Bihar's history: 125 units of free electricity per month for all domestic consumers.

### A New Era of Energy Justice in Bihar

Electricity in Bihar has evolved far beyond its role as an essential utility. Over the past decade, it has become a symbol of empowerment, modernity and equitable growth. The state's decision to offer 125

units of free electricity every month to all domestic consumers from July 1, 2025, represents a profound shift in Bihar's development philosophy. It reinforces the idea that access to reliable electricity is not a luxury but a right—one that the state is committed to upholding for every household.

This decision is not a standalone announcement. It is the culmination of a sustained, long-term reform journey that began when the Honourable Chief Minister vowed in 2012 to electrify every home in the state. Today, the fruits of that commitment are visible in every corner of Bihar—cities growing with confidence, rural economies expanding, households experiencing comfort and safety, and consumers engaging with a modern, digital electricity ecosystem.

## **The Evolution of Subsidy : From Support to Transformation**

Since the unbundling of the Bihar State Electricity Board in November 2012—when five specialised successor companies were formed—the state has followed a clear vision: electricity must remain affordable for every household. Tariff subsidy has been central to this mission, helping bridge the gap between rising consumption and household affordability as electrification expanded rapidly across rural and urban Bihar.

In the years up to 2016–17, this affordability was maintained largely through reduced consumer tariffs, without clearly showing how much the government was contributing. While effective, it masked the true cost of supply and the significant fiscal support extended to consumers.

Post-2017–18, Bihar introduced a transparent billing system in which consumers see the full approved tariff followed by a dedicated line—“Rajya Sarkar ka Anudaan”—showing the exact subsidy deducted from their bill. This reform created one of India's largest and clearest direct benefit reflection mechanisms, strengthening public awareness and trust.

The subsidy's expansion mirrors this commitment. What began as ₹927 crore in 2012–13 rose to ₹2,656

crore in 2013–14 and ₹4,390 crore in 2015–16. With near-universal electrification, it increased to ₹5,494 crore in 2020–21 and ₹7,801 crore in 2022–23. A major leap came in 2023–24 when subsidy nearly doubled to ₹13,114 crore, responding to higher usage and rising household expectations.

Support climbed further to ₹15,343 crore in 2024–25, and ₹15,995 crore was budgeted for 2025–26. Following the landmark decision to provide 125 units of free electricity to all domestic consumers, an additional ₹3,797 crore was sanctioned under the Mukhyamantri Vidyut Upbhokta Sahayata Yojana, taking the total subsidy for FY 2025–26 to ₹19,792 crore.

This progression is more than an increase in consumption—it reflects a deliberate, people-centric policy approach. In Bihar, no family should be denied electricity due to financial constraints. What began as simple support has evolved into a transparent and transformative instrument of social justice, making affordable energy a lived reality for millions.

## **Category-Wise Tariff Support : Ensuring Inclusive Access for All**

### **A. Domestic Consumers : From Essential Access to Full Relief**

Bihar's subsidy architecture is broad, inclusive and responsive, ensuring meaningful tariff protection for every household—rural or urban. Kutir Jyoti (BPL) families remain central to this mission, benefiting for over a decade from some of India's lowest effective tariffs, enabling them to meet essential energy needs with dignity.

Support for rural domestic consumers—NBPCL's largest segment—has expanded rapidly alongside growing electrification and appliance use. This evolution culminated in the landmark 125-unit free electricity initiative, which has effectively eliminated monthly bills for nearly all rural households. Urban domestic consumers, too, continue to receive substantial and predictable tariff relief, ensuring that rising energy demand does not strain middle- and lower-income families.



## B. Agriculture: India's Most Affordable Irrigation Power

For Bihar's farmers, the subsidy framework has been transformative. With irrigation power priced at just 55 paise per unit—over 92% subsidised—the state offers one of India's most affordable agricultural tariffs. Subsidy support, which was ₹385 crore in 2019–20, has grown to ₹4,584 crore in 2025–26, enabling farmers to shift decisively from diesel pumps to reliable, low-cost electric irrigation.

The benefits are widespread: expanded irrigated acreage, diversified crops, higher productivity and sharply reduced operating costs. Recognising the critical link between irrigation and post-harvest value, BERC has extended this same 55-paise IAS tariff to all HT and LT cold storage units storing agricultural produce. This path-breaking step not only lowers storage and preservation costs but also stabilises market prices—ensuring farmers earn more while consumers face fewer price shocks for essential food items.

## C. Industrial, Commercial & Emerging Services: Powering Broad-Based Growth

Beyond households and agriculture, Bihar provides targeted tariff support to small businesses, micro-enterprises, LT and HT industrial consumers, cold storage operators and emerging sectors like EV charging. By keeping tariffs moderate and predictable, the state enables enterprises to expand,

generate local employment and strengthen both rural and urban economic ecosystems.

Bihar's subsidy model thus ensures that every class of consumer—not just the poorest—receives meaningful support, reflecting a commitment to balanced and inclusive growth.

## How Consumers Benefit : Real Relief, Real Dignity, Real Progress

For millions of families, affordable electricity has reshaped daily life. Near-uninterrupted supply has made homes safer, more productive and more comfortable. Children can study longer, women run home-based enterprises confidently, and households have moved away from kerosene to reliable lighting.

Local businesses—from tea stalls to tailoring units and salons—have expanded operating hours and increased earnings simply because electricity is predictable and affordable. In rural areas, continuous power has meant brighter streets, busier markets and a visible rise in evening economic activity.

Electricity in Bihar has become a true enabler—reducing financial stress, expanding opportunity and enhancing dignity across communities.

## The 125-Unit Free Electricity Scheme : A Milestone in Welfare Governance

The decision to provide 125 units of free electricity per month marks a landmark in Bihar's welfare governance. It offers direct, assured and immediate relief to 1.89 crore households—nearly 90% of domestic consumers.

For low- and middle-income families, the benefit is substantial—often equivalent to a week's groceries, school fees or essential medical expenses. It ensures that no household must choose between necessities and electricity. Crucially, long-term aspirations remain protected: even beyond 125 units, tariffs stay subsidised, supporting rising appliance use, better living standards and growing energy needs. The scheme reinforces a simple principle : energy security is a right, not a burden—and Bihar will safeguard that right for every family.

## Jan Samwaad 2025 : A Statewide Exercise in Awareness, Clarity and Consumer Engagement

The rollout of the 125-unit free electricity benefit from August 1, 2025-applicable on July bills-naturally generated many consumer queries about bill calculation, subsidy adjustments and eligibility. To ensure clarity, Bihar launched one of its most extensive awareness drives.

In the weeks before implementation, DISCOMs issued FAQs and explanatory notes, released short videos, podcasts and digital explainers, used local miking, pamphlets and village announcements to reach even remote households. Influencer-led messages on social platforms further helped counter misconceptions.

To reinforce this outreach, a statewide Jan Samwaad was organised on August 12, 2025-designed not as a promotional event, but as a platform for direct dialogue. Over 4,000 camps were convened across districts, blocks and panchayats, enabling nearly 20-25 lakh consumers to seek clarifications, share feedback and understand how the new subsidy framework applied to their individual bills.

In a significant gesture of accountability, the Honourable Chief Minister joined the dialogue through video conference, listening to citizens, responding to concerns and underlining the government's commitment to transparency. For many families, this became an opportunity to express how electricity had shaped their lives-whether through improved study hours for children,

reduced irrigation costs for farmers, extended business hours for shopkeepers or monthly savings under the 125-unit provision.

The Jan Samwaad ultimately served as a bridge between policy and people-a large-scale exercise in awareness, clarity and trust-building. It reaffirmed that consumer involvement is central to Bihar's power-sector governance, and that informed citizens are the strongest partners in sustaining the state's progress.

## Electricity as a Foundation for Equality and Opportunity

The story of Bihar's power sector is, at its core, the story of its people. It reflects what becomes possible when political resolve, administrative discipline and active consumer participation move in the same direction. From the early promise of "Har Ghar Bijli" to today's assurance of affordable electricity, the state has travelled a remarkable distance-expanding supply, reducing losses and building a system anchored in dignity and inclusion.

With these gains, Bihar is now set to deepen its consumer-centric reforms-strengthening reliability, expanding digital services and ensuring that every household experiences not just access to power, but true comfort, convenience and confidence in the electricity system.

# Bihar Power Conclave 2025 : Opportunities for Investment

The Bihar Power Conclave 2025, organized by the Indian Electrical and Electronics Manufacturers' Association (IEEMA), was held at Taj City Centre, Patna, drawing industry leaders, policymakers, and experts from across the country. The event showcased Bihar's rapid transformation in the power sector and emphasized emerging opportunities for investment and technological advancement.

The Conclave was inaugurated by the Hon'ble Minister of Energy, **Shri Bijendra Prasad Yadav**, by lightening the ceremonial lamp. The event was graced by Hon'ble Minister of Industries **Shri Nitish Mishra**, Energy Secretary and Chairman-cum-Managing Director of BSPHCL **Shri Manoj Kumar Singh**, Managing Director of NBPCL & BSPTCL **Shri Rahul Kumar**, along with senior officials and representatives from leading electrical equipment manufacturing companies.

- Investment opportunities and challenges in the power sector
- Bihar Renewable Energy and Pumped storage Policy - 2025

## Bihar Poised for Accelerated Growth: Energy Minister

In his inaugural address, Hon'ble Energy Minister, **Shri Bijendra Prasad Yadav** emphasized Bihar's central role in India's progress, stating that "the country's development is incomplete without Bihar." Highlighting the state's immense potential, he assured that investors would face no difficulties, as the government is committed to providing full support. He reiterated that Bihar is dedicated to ensuring high-quality and uninterrupted power supply, reinforcing its readiness to welcome and facilitate new investments.

## Industry Minister Emphasized Investor-Friendly Reforms

Hon'ble Industries Minister, Shri Nitish Mishra underlined that the new Energy and Industrial Policies have made Bihar one of the most attractive destinations for investors. He noted that approvals are now granted within 7–15 days through the Single Window System. Under the revised Industrial Policy, the state government has also made provisions for free land allocation to eligible investors.

## Transformational Growth in Two Decades

Energy Secretary & CMD, BSPHCL, Shri Manoj Kumar Singh, presented a comprehensive overview of the state's achievements. Under the leadership of Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri Nitish Kumar, Bihar has witnessed a revolutionary transformation in its power sector over the past 20 years.

Key highlights included:

- Investment of nearly ₹60,000 crore completed, with ₹30,000 crore worth of projects currently underway.
- Reliable power supply averaging 23 hours in rural areas and 24 hours in urban regions.
- Free electricity connections for farmers under the Mukhyamantri Krishi Vidyut Sambandh Yojana, with a target to connect maximum farmers to the grid by September 2026.
- Number of grid sub-stations increased fourfold.
- Power evacuation capacity expanded 19 times.
- Industrial consumers increased tenfold.
- AT&C losses reduced from 60% to 15.5%, enabling distribution companies to register profits.





## Strengthening Infrastructure and New Avenues for Investment

MD NBPDC & BSPTCL, Shri Rahul Kumar stated Bihar currently operates 173 grid sub-stations, with 47 more planned over the next decade. The state's 33 kV evacuation capacity has reached 20,000 MW, significantly improving power infrastructure reliability. He invited investors to explore opportunities in sectors such as smart grids, fault-location systems, and lightning protection solutions.



## Recognition from the Industry

IEEMA leadership, including President Shri Utkarsh Bansal, Director General Ms. Charu Mathur, and Chairman Shri Sunil Singhvi, applauded Bihar's Renewable Energy 2025 and Pumped Storage Policies, terming them among the most investor-friendly frameworks in the country. They also praised Bihar's efficient payment policy, calling it one of the best in India.

## A Platform for Collaboration and Vision Setting

Senior officials including BSPTCL Director Shri Awadhesh Kumar Singh, SBPDCL Director (Projects) Shri Deepak Kumar Singh, and NBPDC Director (Projects) Shri I.C. Yadav also addressed the gathering, sharing insights into ongoing developments and future goals.

The Bihar Power Conclave 2025 reaffirmed the state's commitment to sustainable growth, energy security, and innovation in the power sector. With robust policies, enhanced infrastructure, and a proactive governance approach, Bihar is emerging as a dynamic hub for power-sector investments and technological advancements.



# CII International Energy Conference 2025 : Bihar's Power Sector Takes Centre Stage

The 6th International Energy Conference & Exhibition 2025, organised by the Confederation of Indian Industry (CII) at Hotel Taj Palace, New Delhi, featured Bihar as one of the key focus states. Over two days of discussions, exhibitions and high-level dialogues, Bihar showcased how a state once known for power shortages is now emerging as one of India's fastest-improving power ecosystems—ready for investment, growth, and large-scale clean energy deployment.

The Bihar Energy Department led a dedicated one-hour state session titled “Empowering Bihar: Energy for Growth & Sustainability,” which drew strong interest from industry leaders, investors, technology firms, renewable developers, financial institutions, and policymakers.

Throughout the event, Bihar's energy pavilion - set up by the Energy Department - received significant footfall, with multiple investors expressing interest in exploring project opportunities in renewables, BESS, transmission and industrial load centres.

## Bihar's Power Journey : Secretary Energy Sets the Context

Shri Manoj Kumar Singh, IAS, Energy Secretary & CMD, BSPHCL, delivered the keynote presentation and set the tone for the session.

He described how Bihar has scripted one of India's fastest energy turnarounds since the 2012 unbundling, powered by strong political resolve and sustained reforms.

### He highlighted:

- Peak demand met: <700 MW (2005) → 8,752 MW (2025)
- Consumer base: 17 lakh → 2.20 crore
- AT&C losses: ~60% → ~15.5%
- Universal household electrification
- Major expansion in transmission capacity and distribution reliability

Shri Singh emphasised that these outcomes have been enabled by large-scale investments in smart metering, feeder strengthening, sub-transmission, digitalisation, and a clear long-term Resource Adequacy strategy.

He also highlighted Bihar's newest policy enablers—the Renewable Energy Policy 2025, the Pumped Storage Promotion Policy 2025, and the Industrial Investment Promotion Package 2025—which together create a de-risked, investor-friendly environment through long-tenor waivers, banking provisions, land facilitation and payment security mechanisms. Urging investors to “see Bihar with your own eyes, not through old perceptions,” he underlined the State's transparent systems, timely payments and unwavering commitment to partnership-driven growth in the energy sector.

### High-Level Panel : Leaders From India's Energy & Investment Ecosystem

The panel on “Empowering Bihar: Energy for Growth and Sustainability” brought together major national and international stakeholders:

The discussion highlighted Bihar's major improvements in energy access, distribution efficiency, grid upgrades, and stable payment mechanisms—key elements that investors look for.

Shri Ghanshyam Prasad appreciated Bihar's consistent improvements in grid reliability, tariff discipline and loss reduction, noting that the State's planning and payment reforms have aligned it well with national standards and improved its ability to integrate future renewable capacity.

One of the most impactful reflections came from Shri Jitendra Srivastava, CMD REC Ltd., who spoke not only as a financier but as someone who has spent over twenty-five years serving Bihar—as District Magistrate in four districts and later as Managing Director of the Generation Company and both DISCOMs. He shared his personal account of watching Bihar's electricity landscape transform from <700 MW to more than 8,700 MW of demand met, and from 2 million to over 21 million consumers, while witnessing AT&C losses fall from nearly 60 percent to around 15 percent. He praised the State's rapid adoption of over 77 lakh smart prepaid meters, digital substations, GIS grids and a well-defined Resource Adequacy Plan till 2034.

He also pointed out how Bihar's RE Policy 2025, Pumped Storage Policy 2025 and Industrial Investment Package 2025 collectively lower the cost of capital and improve project viability. Speaking as CMD REC, he highlighted Bihar's timely, disciplined and outcome-oriented utilisation of RDSS funds—an indicator of strong governance and reliability for investors—and reaffirmed REC-PFC's commitment to supporting the State in scaling storage, pumped storage and digital distribution systems.



Shri Kundan Kumar, IAS, MD BIADA & Investment Commissioner, presented Bihar's wider industrial journey, emphasising the State's strategic location, multimodal connectivity and access to a 400-million-people regional market. He outlined BIADA's plug-and-play industrial parks, ready-to-allot land bank and an evolving MSME ecosystem supported by skilled manpower. Through the BIIPP 2025 incentives—capital subsidy, SGST reimbursement, interest subvention and fast single-window clearances—he underscored that Bihar today offers policy stability, reliable power, quick approvals and a highly supportive government ready to facilitate investment across sectors.

Industry leaders representing Adani Group, Intellismart and L&T Renewables expressed strong appreciation for Bihar's transparent working environment, predictable payment mechanisms and quick decision-making. They noted that the State's progress in smart metering, digitalisation, renewable adoption and grid strengthening has made it one of the most reliable destinations for private-sector participation. The ease of coordination with the Energy Department, the professionalism of utilities and the speed with which issues are resolved were highlighted as major advantages for investors.

The Vote of Thanks was delivered by Shri Rahul Kumar, IAS, Managing Director of NBPCL, who

acknowledged the insights shared by the panel and expressed gratitude to CII for providing a national platform to showcase Bihar's achievements. He reiterated the State Government's commitment to reliable, affordable and consumer-centric power supply, and emphasised how the Energy Department and DISCOMs are working as a unified team to support investors, strengthen operational performance and accelerate project execution. His remarks reinforced the message that Bihar today is not just improving—it is consistently delivering results.

### **Another Key Session: PPAs vs Trading – The DISCOM Dilemma**

Later in the conference, a special technical session on "Power Procurement through PPAs or Trading – A Discom Dilemma" featured active participation from Shri Manoj Kumar Singh.

#### **The discussion covered:**

- Strengthening financial sustainability of DISCOMs
- Evolving procurement strategies
- Balancing long-term PPAs with short-term trading
- Ensuring least-cost power procurement

Experts appreciated Bihar's transparent procurement practices and improving counterparty credibility.



## Strong Industry Participation

The event saw participation from a wide range of companies including renewable developers, BESS providers, transmission EPCs, financial institutions, OEMs and industrial groups. Major players such as Adani Group, L&T, Intellismart, Tata Power, Avaada and Reliance Power engaged deeply with Bihar's delegation, showing strong confidence in the State's emerging potential.

हम रहे सदैव प्रगतिशील, हो नवीकरणीय ऊर्जा का विस्तार,







# याद है शहादत की वो कहानी



यह संक्षिप्त कहानी क्रांतिकारी रामप्रसाद ‘बिस्मिल’ से जुड़ी है जो आज भी देशभक्ति के लिए हमें प्रेरित करती है। शहादत से पहले वीरमाता मुलमती उनसे मिलने पहुँची, तो उनकी डबडबाई आँखे देखकर भी कमज़ोर नहीं पड़ी, अपने कलेजे पर पत्थर रखकर उलाहना देती हुई बोली, अरे मैं तो समझती थी कि मेरा बेटा बहुत बहादुर है, और अंग्रेज सरकार उसके नाम से थर-थर काँपती है, मुझे पता नहीं था कि मौत से इतना डरता है। उन्होंने फिर उनसे पूछा, रो-रोकर ही सूती चढ़ता था, तो तुने इस पर कदम ही क्यों रखा? ‘बिस्मिल’ ने बिना पल गँवाये अपनी आँखे पोंछ डाली और कहा, गलत मत समझ माँ, मेरी आँखे मौत के खोफ से नहीं, यह सोचकर कर डबडबा आयी थीं कि अब उन्हें तेरे जैसी बहादुर माँ को देखना मयस्सर नहीं होगा, कुछ ही दिनों पहले उन्होंने इस माँ को पत्र लिखा था। जीवन सफल करूँ, किन्तु यह इच्छा पुरी होती नजर नहीं आती, शायद तुम्हें जल्दी ही मेरी फांसी की सूचना मिले। माँ मुझे विश्वास हैं, कि तुम यह समझकर धैर्य रख लोगी कि तुम्हारा पुत्र भारत माता की सेवा की भेंट चढ़ गया। उसने तुम्हारी कोख को कलंकित नहीं किया।

ऐतिहासिक काकोरी ट्रेन से सरकारी खजाना लूटकांड एक्शन में पकड़ लिये जाने के कारण अशफाक उल्लाह खान, राजेन्द्र नाथ लाहिड़ी और रौशन सिंह के साथ क्रांतिकारी राम प्रसाद ‘बिस्मिल’ को भी मौत की सजा हुई थी। शहादत से पहले मजिस्ट्रेट ने बिस्मिल से उनकी अंतिम इच्छा पूछी, तो उन्होंने कहा था, मैं ब्रिटिश राज का सर्वनाश चाहता हूँ। उन्होंने कवि के रूप में कुल न्यारह किताबें लिखी थी।

अपनी शहादत से दो दिन पहले तक वे जेल के अन्दर अधिकारियों की नजर बचा कर अपनी आत्मकथा लिखते रहे और किश्तों में बाहर भेजवा रहे थे। उन्होंने लिखा था कि मैं प्राण त्यागते समय निराश नहीं हूँ, न ही यह सोचता हूँ कि हमलोगों की बलिदान व्यर्थ है। उनकी कामना थी। ऐ मातृभूमि। तेरी जय हो, सदा विजय हो, प्रत्येक भक्त तेरा, सुख शांति-क्रांतिमय हो, दिल फिदा करते हैं, कुर्बान जिगर करते हैं। पास जो कुछ है वो माता को नजर करते हैं। राम प्रसाद ‘बिस्मिल’; की यह क्रांतिकारी पंक्ति आज भी हमें हौसला देती है।




