### Office Order

In transmission projects, the GTP (Guaranteed Technical Particulars) and Drawings of the different equipment/materials are the detailed documents submitted by a bidder/vendor, outlining the specific technical specifications and performance characteristics of the equipment or material they will supply. This requires approval from the employer to ensure the proposed design meets the issued technical specifications, safety standards, relevant IS, IEC as well as CEA, CBIP guidelines etc. and project intent before manufacturing of the equipment/materials. The various standards/guidelines are being updated/ modified from time-to-time to match with the technological advancement and prevalent industry practices. As such, both GTP and drawing approval are crucial steps to ensure the supplied equipment is correct, suitable for the project, and conforms to the tender/ contract terms & conditions.

It has been observed that the EPC Contractors/Manufacturers are directly raising inspection calls based on the previously approved GTP and drawings of different equipment/materials without taking project specific adoption/ approval, which is not in line with the provisions contained in SBD.

As per SBD clause no. 43.2 project specific approval is needed to ensure quality & correctness of the equipment/materials as per Type Test reports and in line with the issued Technical Specification complying with the relevant IS, IEC, CEA, CBIP guidelines etc.

In light of the above facts, the office order issued vide order no. 18 dated 08.05.2025 regarding adoption of vendor with associated GTP/Drawings for all ongoing/upcoming projects under BSPTCL is hereby modified to the following extent: -

1. The EPC Contractors/Manufacturers have to select the vendors with associated GTP & Drawings from the uploaded approved vendor list/ propose new vendors (if required) and submit complete proposal to P&E Dept. of BSPTCL along with the valid type test reports (if applicable) as per CEA guidelines, undertaking regarding debarment/ blacklisting and compliance of SBD/TS/IS/IEC for adoption/approval.
2. P&E Dept. after checking & verification of the complete proposals in line with the issued Technical Specifications, relevant IS, IEC as well as CEA, CBIP guidelines etc. submitted by the EPC Contractors/Manufacturer shall issue adoption/approval letter within 07 days.

The above modifications shall come in to force with immediate effect.


